

Fall 2010 Graduation Rates

- Summer 2015 44.76%
- Fall 2015 46.69%
- Spring 2016 50.15%
- Summer 2016 **51.88%**

Fall 2011 Graduation Rates

- Summer 2016 48.17%
- Summer 2017 (goal) **54.26%** (if 60 of the 73 graduate)
